Norfolk SEN Network currently has 4 Development Workers working a variety of hours across the county. You will:

- 1. Supervise and support all Development Workers and the Administrator.
- 2. Check in weekly with each Development Worker to ensure that the cases they are managing are moving forward.
- 3. Hold monthly meetings with each Development Worker to go through their cases in detail and check they are following appropriate procedures.
- 4. To cover cases for Development Workers when they are unable to do so due to sickness or other commitments.
- 5. To reallocate the cases currently managed by the Senior Development Worker to other Development Workers.
- 6. Write a report for Trustee and Committee meetings to include the number of cases Development Workers are working on, new cases, tribunals and highlight any concerns, trends etc.
- 7. Any other work specified by the Trustees.
